

Model for Conditions of Sale Applicable to Seed Lots¹

(Chicago, May 2002)

Seeds supplied to you are from a variety bred from parent components that have not been genetically modified. The methods used in the development and maintenance of that variety are aimed at avoiding the presence of off-types, including genetically modified material, as defined by the applicable laws or regulations.

Seed production has been carried out in accordance with production rules including stipulated isolation distances. However, in open fields there is free circulation of pollen. As it cannot be excluded that in seed multiplication areas the growing of approved GM plants takes place, it is not possible to totally prevent the adventitious presence of GM material and to guarantee that the seed lots comprising this delivery are free from any traces derived from GM plants.

(Company name) has undertaken due diligence to avoid adventitious presence of GM material in this seed lot. However, (company name) gives no guarantee that the seed is GM free and can accept no liability arising from the adventitious presence of GM material.
