You will report directly to ISF's Seed Health Manager with whom you closely align on the governance of ISHI's project portfolio and will provide technical support for the outreach to external stakeholders (f.e. NPPOs).

This is a full-time position within a small team, the position entails occasional international travel and is home based.

- provide technical and editorial feedback on written outputs arising from the ISHI projects
- to respond to the changing needs of the International Seed Federation, performing other tasks as reasonably required.
