## THE ORGANISATION

### **VACANCY**

The Regulatory Affairs Manager will be working within the ISF Secretariat, reporting directly to ISF's Secretary General.

### **KEY TASKS**

Together with ISF's members, (s)he will spearhead efforts to build broader understanding within and outside the seed sector on the seed sector's contribution to the different forms of agricultural production.

(S)he will be a key point person of ISF with relevant international organizations that establish various standards related to seed quality and govern the international movement of seeds such as OECD Seed Schemes, UPOV Technical Committee and ISTA.

(S)he will be in charge of overseeing the international policy developments related to plant breeding innovation, and access to new plant varieties, to achieve consistent, science- and risk-based regulations across different countries.

(S)he will be in charge of issues related to Vegetable and Ornamental crops, and managing the different ISF activities of data collection on seed marketing and international seed trade.
